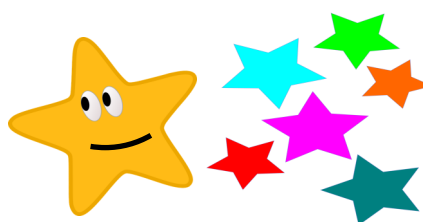

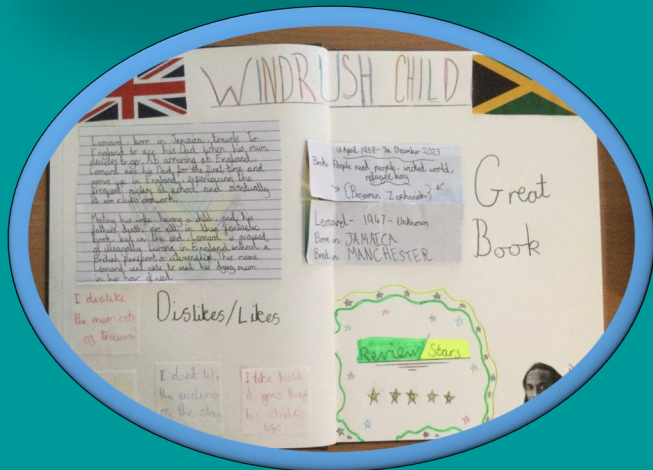
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Over half term week we had some lovely new windows installed in the school hall that look very smart .
