
Year 3 KIRF Spring 1

Key instant recall facts (KIRFS) are designed to support the development of key arithmetic skills which underpin much of the maths learning at school. Supporting your child(ren) in learning these facts and being able to recall them quickly will help enormously with progression in maths.



Ways you could help your children to learn these:

Count in multiples of 3 when playing or tidying toys.

Count out small snacks in 3's e.g. raisins, small sweets.

Counting the number of lights in sets of traffic lights when out and about.

Draw a map of a town with traffic lights at junctions and count in 3's.
