Ways you could help your children to learn these:

Count in multiples of 6 when playing or tidying toys.

Count out boxes of eggs in 6's.

Use dice to count in 6's by looking at the number of faces on each dice.

Look out for soft drink bottles that are packed in groups of 6 and use these to count in 6's.
