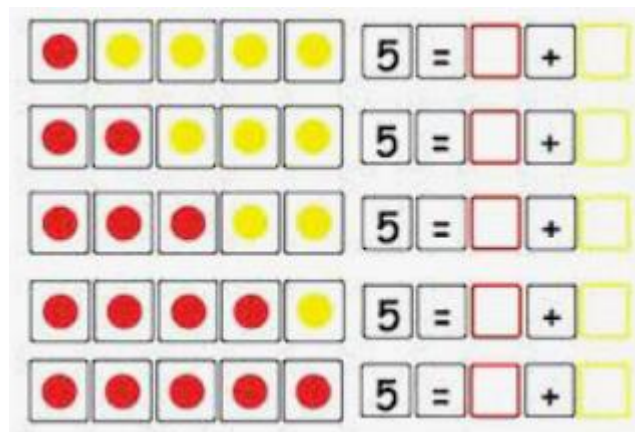


EYFS KIRF Summer 1

Key instant recall facts (KIRFS) are designed to support the development of key arithmetic skills which underpin much of the maths learning at school. Supporting your child(ren) in learning these facts and being able to recall them quickly will help enormously with progression in maths.



Recall number bonds up to 5

Having this knowledge stored in the long-term memory, allows children to work through addition and subtraction with more fluidity, and confidence with their maths when learning new concepts.

$$0+5=5$$

$$1+4=5$$

$$2+3=5$$

$$3+2=5$$

$$4+1=5$$

$$5+0=5$$

In addition, you can also keep working on:

Practice partitioning 5 with interesting objects

Writing numerals 0-10 with matching pictures

1:1 correspondence-Counting objects form a larger quantity

Cardinality-Having counted them out, understanding that they know how many they have, without recounting when asked how many are in the group.
