Geography

Focus: The World

Pupils will develop knowledge about the seven continents and the five oceans.

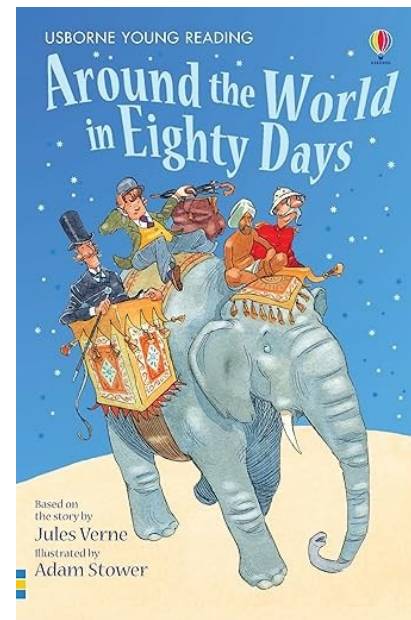
Geographical skills: Children will be locating and labelling the seven continents and the five oceans on a map. They will locate hot areas in relation to the equator and cold areas in relation to the North/South Pole. They will also be using simple compass directions.



Science

Focus: Plants—Bulbs and temperature on growth

Scientific skills: observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants; find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Focus: Preparing fruit and vegetables

Key Texts: *Atlas*, *Around the World in 80 Days*, various poetry books

Purpose for writing: Writing to inform—instructions; poetry with jokes and riddles

Writing: Children will learn to write instructions and explore different forms of poetry that are jokes and/or riddles.

Grammar: Children will learn to write instructions in chronological order using appropriate vocabulary. Including sequential connectives, imperative verbs and prepositions.

Phonics: Y1 Phase 5: ur/ir; igh/ie; oo/yoo; oa/o; ligh/i ai/a; ee/e; ai/a-e; igh/i-e; oa/o-e; oo/ yoo/ u-e; ee/ e-e; oo/yoo/ew; ee/ie; or/aw.

Grammar: Y2 statements, commands, exclamation, questions, subordinating conjunctions, co-ordinating conjunctions.

Reading: Using the text *Here We Are* by Oliver Jeffers, children will focus on:

Vocabulary	Explain
Inference	Retrieve
Prediction	Summarise

Maths

Addition and Subtraction: Y1 children will learn methods for addition and subtraction up to 20; Y2 will learn methods for addition and subtraction up to 100 including adding and subtracting money.

Multiplication: Y1 children will continue to consolidate place value up to 50 and learn methods of multiplication; Y2 children will learn the formal written methods for multiplication.
